



CAMPERS LIST: WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

General Items

- Bible, notebook and pen or pencil
- Sleeping bag or a blanket and sheet
- Pillow and pillow case
- Towel, washcloth and soap
- Beach Towel
- Personal Toiletries (Shampoo, Soap, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Deodorant, etc.)
- Laundry bag
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Water Bottle

Clothing

- Underwear and socks
- Pajamas
- T-shirts
- Jeans, sweatpants
- Shorts
- Sweatshirts or light jacket
- Modest Swimsuit *
- Footwear: Sandals, Running Shoes
- Hat
- Rain Gear
- Fancy Friday Attire**

Optional Items

- Personal Skill Equipment such as fishing rod, water ski, lifejacket
- Flashlight
- Sunglasses

General – Camp is not a place to make a fashion statement. Clothing should be neither extreme nor provocative.

***Swimsuits** – Girls should not wear bikinis or any suits that are extreme or immodest; guys should not wear speedos or trunks without a drawstring and liner.

Tuck Money – Do not bring any money! Tuck is no extra charge. T-shirts and souvenirs are available for purchase on the first and last day of camp (during camper drop off and pick up).

****Fancy Friday Attire.** It has become a custom that campers and staff dress up for the last chapel of the week and or special events. This is completely optional.

Please do not bring – Gum, Sunflower Seeds, cigarettes, matches, lighters, cell phones or other electronic gear, pocket knives or expensive jewelry. **The camp is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.**

How to pack – **Please label all items** with the camper's name! If possible, all articles except bedding should be packed in one suitcase or duffer bag. Bedding should be secured in one well tied roll. If using garbage bags, double them up and send extra bags for the trip home. All items must be labelled. Please send this list with the camper to camp so they can check off items when they pack to go home.
