OUR CAMPS

All of our 2018 camps are six day camps—Monday through Saturday. Each cabin houses 2 counselors and 8 campers. On Saturday, when parents pick up their camper, there is a Parents’ Program and BBQ lunch before departure.

Kindle is for campers who will be in grades **3 to 6** in the fall. Our Kindle camps will be **July 2 - 7** and **July 30-August 4**. Kindle campers experience a great week through choosing four skills, having a blast at our Kindle Carnival and finish off the week with a campfire under the stars!

Spark will be **August 13 -18** for campers who will be in grades **5 to 7** in the fall. It takes a combination of features from Kindle and Ignite and creates a unique experience for these campers. Spark campers may have a one on one CIT (Counselor in Training) as their Big Brother or Sister. It is a Spark tradition to have a fireside at the snowmobile shack that is a little ways from camp.

Ignite 1 during **July 9 - 14** is for campers who will be in grades **6 to 9** in the fall, and **Ignite 2, August 20 - 25** is for campers who will be in grades **6 to 8** in the fall. Ignite campers experience the fantastic camp-wide game, worship night and special events that are sure to be a hit!

Summer Scorcher is **July 23 - 28** and is for campers who will be in grades **9 to 12** in the fall. This is a week when our staff go all out with some high energy programs like our annual Home-made Jam, an evening of comedy acts, music and skits that our staff will perform for the campers along with the infamous beach party! There is always something fun to do at Summer Scorcher with many all group activities, beach volleyball and plenty of time to just hang out together!

Summer Sizzler 1, July 16 - 21 and **Summer Sizzler 2, August 6 -11** are for campers who will be in grades **7 to 10** in the fall. Summer Sizzler will be a blend of some of the features of our Ignite and Summer Scorcher sessions. There is always something new at Sizzler, like our night game, and coffee house. Be part of the excitement at Sizzler!

Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Camp is a co-ed camp for Christian youth with leadership potential who will be entering grade **11 or 12** in the fall. This **two week** camp, **August 13-25**, includes learning camping and counseling skills, participating in cabin group Bible studies, a weekend camp out and the opportunity to be a big brother or sister to a young camper. CIT Camp is a time for spiritual growth, leadership development, excitement and building lasting friendships with a small group of committed Christians. Camperships: A campership fund has been established to enable children from low income families to attend camp. Contact the camp office for information.

When our office has received your completed registration and **full payment**, an acceptance letter, list of things to bring to camp, and transportation information will be sent to you. **If you are paying by credit card, you may fax your registration to (204-326-1387). Applications without a health form will not be processed.**

WAIVERS AND CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

1. **Right To Dismiss:** The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper, who in his opinion, is a hazard to the safety and rights of others, or who appears to have rejected the reasonable controls of camp. Transportation in such cases shall be provided by the parents, guardians or sponsoring agency. The parent/guardian certifies that the applicant camper is normal in condition and habits and is amenable to necessary camp discipline.
2. **Substance Policy:** Possession and /or use of tobacco products, non-prescriptive drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited.
3. **Legal Custody:** The parents or guardians submitting this application are those having legal custody over the child. Conditions of custody, if applicable, will be fully communicated in writing to the camp, including a photocopy of the section of any court order referring to visitation rights.
4. **Photo Release:** The parents or guardians submitting this application give their permission for any photographs or videos of camp activities which may include their child, to be used in camp promotional materials (including the world wide web) and brochures without any financial compensation.
5. **Activity Participation:** The parent/guardian grants permission for the camper to participate in all Red Rock Bible Camp activities.
6. **Liability:** While every precaution is taken for the safety and good health of our campers, Red Rock Bible Camp, its directors and staff members, or the employees of facilities outside of the campgrounds are hereby released from any and all liability in the event of an illness, accident or misfortune that may occur to the applicant camper. Each camper must be covered by Provincial Health (or equivalent) medical insurance.
7. **Personal Information:** The parent/guardian understands that personal information gathered by Red Rock Bible Camp is used by the camp for it's own purposes and is stored in a secure place.
8. **Cancellation & Refund Policy:** If cancellation is made three WEEKS or more prior to your camp session, the fee **LESS the non-refundable deposit** will be refunded. If cancellation is made **LESS THAN THREE WEEKS** prior to the camp session, there is **NO REFUND** except for medical emergencies with a doctors note. There is no refund for campers who withdraw from camp for any reason during the camp session, or who are sent home for disciplinary or medical reasons.
