



CHECK LIST OF SUGGESTED ITEMS CAMPERS NEED TO BRING TO CAMP

General Items

- Bible, notebook and pen or pencil
- Sleeping bag or a blanket and sheet
- Pillow and pillow case
- Towel, washcloth and soap
- Beach Towel
- Comb or brush
- Personal Toiletries (Shampoo, Soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, Deodorant, etc.)
- Laundry bag
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Water Bottle

Optional Items

- Personal Skill Equipment such as fishing rod, water ski

- Flashlight
- Sunglasses

Clothing

- Underwear and socks
- Pajamas
- T-shirts
- Jeans, sweatpants
- Shorts
- Sweatshirts or light jacket
- Swimwear *
- Footwear: Sandals, Running Shoes
- Hat
- Rain Gear
- Fancy Friday Attire **
- Tropical Tuesday Attire ***

General – Camp is not a place to make a statement or draw attention to yourself. Clothing should be neither extreme, offensive nor provocative. If it is even a little questionable, it makes more sense to just bring something else.

***Swimsuits** – Camp is an active place. Please choose bathing suits that are secure and with good coverage.

Tuck Money – Do not bring any money! Tuck is no extra charge. T-shirts and souvenirs are available for purchase on the first and last day of camp (during camper drop off and pick up).

**** Fancy Friday Attire.** It has become a custom that campers and staff dress up for the last chapel of the week and or special events. This is completely optional.

***** Tropical Tuesday.** Another custom is dressing tropical on Tuesdays. If you have anything with Hawaiian prints or bright colors, you may want to bring that. But don't worry, not everyone dresses up for this day, so you don't need to go and buy anything special – a sunny attitude is plenty!

Please do not bring – Gum, Sunflower seeds, cigarettes, matches, lighters, cell phones or other electronic gear, pocket knives or expensive jewelry. **The camp is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.**

How to pack – **Please label all items** with the camper's name! If possible, all articles except bedding should be packed in one suitcase or duffel bag. Bedding should be secured in one well tied roll. If using garbage bags, double them up and send extra bags for the trip home. All items must be labeled. *Please send this list with the camper to camp so they can check off items when they pack to go home.*
